Charles R. Gority, Jr.

WHEREAS, The Almighty has called to His eternal reward one of our brothers, Mr. Charles R. Gority, Jr., a practicing attorney, who died on September 23, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Blair County Bar Association Board of Governors has called an assembly of the Blair County Bench and Bar in profound sorrow to make this memorial tribute to a fellow attorney; and

WHEREAS, the Committee designated by Mary Lou Maierhofer, President of the Blair County Bar Association, respectfully submits the following Resolution upon the passing of Charles R. Gority, Jr., whose death brought profound sorrow to all of those who knew him.

Charles R. Gority, Jr., was born June 15, 1947 in Altoona, Pennsylvania, a son of Charles and Alverta Gority. He was a 1965 graduate of Bishop Guilfoyle High School and graduated from the Pennsylvania State University. Charlie worked for the Social Security Administration for a number of years prior to entering law school. He received a law degree from the Ohio Northern University in 1986 and was admitted to the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania that year.

Charlie served as a Lieutenant in the Army in the Vietnam War and after serving honorably in the Army Reserves, he resigned his commission with the rank of Captain. Charlie spent his Blair County law career as a sole practitioner specializing in Social Security law. He also served as an assistant Public Defender for Blair County from 1986 until 1990.

He married Kathleen McNelis-Barnes in Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania in 2005.

Charlie was able to weave his wide range of knowledge into his colorful sense of humor and he always entertained those around him. Charlie enjoyed spending time with his family, reading and traveling. He is survived by his wife Kathleen and extended family.


Charles R. Gority, Jr., Esquire will be missed by all who knew and loved him. We cannot understand the brevity of life's span and words are wholly inadequate to express our deep sense of loss at his passing.


Our Bar, profession and community have lost a valued leader and friend.


